C S Geddes would obviously have continued to use some of the views used on George Geddes cards before World War One. For example CGED 06 is same photo as GGED 21 (Main St West) which was issued around 1908.

There is also overlap between a number of publishers - Peter Grieve (prewar), Johnston, Cockburn, C S Geddes and possibly Anonymous 1930s - in terms of views and styles of inscription on front and/or back, suggesting sharing of photographs and also printers. The postcards concerned are listed below:
